 This Indenture made and entered into on the day in the year of our Lord 1832
 between William T. Magrath of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia of the one part and Arthur
 T. Magrath of the same County and State of the other part. It is witnessed that the said William T.
 Magrath for and on consideration of the sum of fifty Dollars current money of this Commonwealth
 to him in hand paid by the said Arthur T. Magrath, at or before the making and delivery of
 these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged both granted and bargained and solemnly
 expressed and confirmed and by these presents doth grant, bargain and sell unto and confirm
 unto him the said Arthur T. Magrath, his heirs and assigns forever all the right title interest
 claim or demand which he the said William T. Magrath, now has or ever hereafter might
 have or have to the lower lands of Mary J. Magrath, widow of Nicholas A. Magrath dec'd, lying
 and being in the aforesaid County of Southampton and Parish of St. Andrew's containing by
 a late Survey One hundred and forty one acres (or the same more or less) as will appear
 by the report of the Commissioners who were appointed by a Writ of the County Court of Southampton
 to divide the lands of said Nicholas A. Magrath dec'd, for the several parts of the said lower land
 reference may be had to the said Commissioners' report, bearing date the 23rd day of February
 One thousand Eight hundred and twenty nine. To have and to hold all the right title interest
 claim or demand of him the said William T. Magrath, of us and to the said blessed land
 of Mary J. Magrath, with all and singular unto the appurtenances, to said right title interest if
 any, or in any-wise appertaining unto him the said Arthur T. Magrath, his heirs
 and assigns forever to and for the only proper use and behoof of him the said Arthur
 T. Magrath, his heirs and assigns forever. And the said William T. Magrath
 for himself his heirs Executors and Administrators doth hereby warrant and agree to and
 with the said Arthur T. Magrath, his heirs Executors Administrators and assigns that he will
 by these presents, when and as far as he shall defend the right title and interest in the lower land
 of said Mary J. Magrath, his heirs assigns against the claims or demands of all and every
 person or persons whatsoever. In Witness whereof the said William T. Magrath, hath hereunto
