Magget his heirs and assigns forever and the said William T. Magget for myself my heirs Executors and assigns the said Jacob's Pasture to the said William T. Magget his heirs Executors and assigns against me the said William T. Magget my Executors and assigns and against all and every other person or persons who have or shall and lawfully claim and for ever defend by these presents In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal this 16 day of July 1832

the said Henry Senow the receipt whereof the said Robert Eames and his wife and John Eames do hereby acknowledge and themselves fully satisfied as to the same do by these presents acquit the said Henry Senow they the said Robert Eames and his wife and John Eames have granted bargain and sold alone and conveyed and confirmed and by these presents do grant bargain and sell alone and conveyed and confirmed unto the said Henry Senow one certain lot of plantation or parcel of land containing by estimation Ten acres being the same more or less lying and being situate in the County of Prince George State of Virginia Beginning at a point on the North side of the Smithfield Road a Corner Tree between A Senow Richard A Senow and a straight line to a large old stump and thence to a corner a Cedar Stump thence across the Senow Road along a corner of marked trees to a corner pine thence a corner of marked trees to the Smithfield Road then Corner Cedar Stump thence down the said Road to the point began at. with the above together with all the singular appurtenances thereto belonging over any and every person with the reversion and reversion remainder and remainders heirs assigns and assigns forever To have and to hold the said bargain premises with the appurtenances unto Henry Senow his heirs and assigns forever and the said Robert Eames and his wife and John Eames for themselves their heirs Executors and administrators the said bargain premises with every part and parcel thereof with all their appurtenances clear except and secure from all claims or other incumbrances which ever unto the said Henry Senow his heirs and
