of the third part all of the County of Southampton. Whereas that whereas the said James
Pochelle stands bound as Security for the said John Edwards of 13th County and made payable
to Sept Lankford for the sum of two thousand dollars dated the 24th day of July 1832 and payable
on demand and whereas the said John Edwards is willing and desirous to disannul and indemnify
and make adequate indemnity to the said James Pochelle against all loss or injury which he
may sustain or consequent of his aforesaid Security by conveying the property herein after
mentioned unto the said John Edwards R. Edwards in trust to be sold for that purpose. Therefore
therefore this Indenture Whereas that the said John Edwards for and in consideration
of the premises and of the sum of One dollar he has in hand paid by the said John Edwards
Edwards the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged by the said John Edwards
has given granted bargained and sold and by these presents doth give grant bargain and
conform unto the said John Edwards the following property to wit all that tract or parcel
of Land lying and being in the County of Southampton containing about three hundred acres
the same more or less and bounded by the road from Belfield to Somerton, by a road leading
from the said Road to the (rope) rays by the lands of Francis J. Jones Thomas Turner and
John Sheppard (formerly Harry) C. being the parts of two tracts of Land one derived by
purchase from Mr. Brown as will more fully appear by a deed now of record in
