Oris A. Brown of the first part, Lieutenant W. Edwards of the second part and James Rochelle
of the third part all of the County of Southampton Witnesses that whereas the said James
Rochelle stands bound as security for the said Oris A. Brown to a Bond entered and made payable
to Sept Lankford for the sum of two thousand Dollars dated the 21st day of July 1832 in pay of a
bond and as the said Oris A. Brown is willing and desirous to discharge and indem-
nify and make agree to indemnify the said James Rochelle against all loss or injury which he
may sustain or consequence of his aforesaid Securityship by conveying the property herein after
mentioned unto the said Lieutenant W. Edwards in trust to be sold for that purpose & 1000th
Therefore this Indenture Witnesses that the said Oris A. Brown for and in consideration
of the promises and of the sum of One dollar to him in hand paid by the said Lieutenant W.
