Edwards (or in case of his death for his legal personal representatives or representatives) at the request of the said James Rockwell his Executor or administrators, after a notice in writing the time and place and terms of sale at least thirty days previous thereto proceed to sell the tract of Land aforesaid and its appurtenances to the highest bidder for cash and out of the moneys arising therefrom first pay and discharge all reasonable costs and expenses attending the sale and then conveyance in the second place pay and satisfy the Rent herein first made to be due to the said John Langford with the interest and Costs which may have accrued thereon, or so much as shall be in arrear at the time and in the third place the surplus of any pay to the said Orris A. Brown or such person as is legally authorized to receive the same And the said Orris A. Brown hereby covenants with the said William R. Edwards that he is possessed of an absolute estate of fee simple in the lands aforesaid and that he covenants for warranty the title hereby conveyed against all persons whosoever. Witnesseth that the said Samuel Williams for and in consideration of the sum of One hundred and fifty Dollars to him in hand paid at or before the sealing and delivering hereof hath granted bargained sold aliened and confirmed and by these presents hath fully and absolutely granted bargained sold aliened and confirmed unto him the said William R. Edwards his heirs and assigns One certain tract or parcel of Land lying and being within the County of Southampton and State of Virginia by collocation containing One acre more or less bounded as follows to wit Beginning at a Hickory a corner between said deities land thence along a line of marked trees to the Road thence along the road to a corner a corner and Samuel Williams and said William R. Edwards have thence along the said deities land to the first Station at which they have corner for one acre more or less together with all some or parts
