The condition of the above obligation is such that whereas the above bound James D Bryant has been duly appointed by the Court of Southampton County to serve as Constable within the said County until June Court 1833 in the room of James Blaw. Now if the said James D Bryant shall well and truly discharge the duties of the Office of Constable in the said County during his Continuance therein then the above obligation to be void or else to remain in full force and virtue.
