Witnesseth the said Bolling Black for the sum of One Dollar with him paid to me by the said Salah Ellsworth the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged do buy and sell deliver and confirm unto the said Matthew Wick one certain tract or parcel of land lying and being Situate in the aforesaid County of Southampton and State of Virginia Beginning and bounded by Margaret Black, Jacob Black and Benjamin Burns land Containing by estimation Twenty six acres be the same more or less with all houses and every appurtenances therunto belonging or in anywise therunto appertaining also one Chesnut horse Mare Eight head of Cattle Twenty head of Hogs Six head of Sheep Two further beds and furniture also one more furnished and furnished one Walnut Table One Maple desk, twelve sitting chairs, one pine chest one gun one pair of glass, wine two sofas, also all the kitchen furniture and plantation utensils of all description to secure a debt due to the above mentioned Matthew Wick of Three hundred and fifty five dollars and twenty six cents due as of Bonds bearing date equal to these presently recorded for order that the said Bolling Black should on due time pay unto the said Matthew Wick the above mentioned debt and interest when then due to be paid, or else to remain in the hands of the said Salah Ellsworth to sell all the above mentioned property appuable to him to pay the said debt and cost that may then on a come and after such to reserve the amount that may originate for his Guardianship of Sally Wick orphan of Samuel Wick deceased and after all the debts and costs above mentioned is fully paid off and satisfied the remainder of such sales shall be paid over unto the said Bolling Black or his heirs or assigns.
