shall approve. Convey and assign to the said Celia Bryant and her heirs free from all
Manner of encumbrances all that tract of Land lying adjoyning Henry Kincer's and Evans
Bryant lines & supposed to be Ten acres more or less and the said Celia Bryant in Consideration
of the Covenant and agreement herein before contained on the part of the said
Thomas Bryant doth hereby for himself his heirs executors and administrators covenant
and agree with the said Thomas Bryant that the said Celia Bryant his heirs executors
and administrators shall and will upon making and executing such conveyance and
assignments as aforesaid pay or cause to be paid unto the said Thomas Bryant his heirs
executors and administrators the sum of fifty dollars as and for an in full consideration
of the absolute purchase of the said tract or parcel of Land at Wethersfield whereof he had
henceunto set his hands and affixes our seals the above date witness.

This Indenture made and executed this day of 2d August A.D. One thousand Eighty
hundred and thirty two. Between Hinckley et al McLenny and Phoebe McLenny his wife of
the one part and Ellen Daugherty of the other part of the County of Hampshire and Hinckley &
Phoeby et al McLenny of the County of Southampton Hantsfrish that the said Hinckley and
Phoeby et al McLenny have for and in Consideration of the sum of two hundred and twenty
seven dollars and twenty two cents granted bargained and sold and by these presents
to grant bargain and sell unto Ellen Daugherty his wife and assigns forever
one certain tract and parcel of Land containing by Survey one hundred and forty
and three fourths acres which land the said Hinckley et al McLenny and Phoeby
et al McLenny do oblige and bind themselves to deliver on or before the 25th day next
over and is bounded as follows Beginning at a big wood near the River
