McKeel the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged each given granted bargain and sold and by these presents do give grant bargain and sell to the said William A. McKeel a certain tract of Land lying and being in the County of Southampton and bounded as follows on the North East by the (Haw River as it is called on the North by the main run of the said McKeel's Mill Pond also the run of the Mill Swamp on the West by the line of Benjamin Blount's Estate on the South by James Taylor's Land and on the South West by Benjamin E. Pope and E. H. Curci or Johnson's Land to the beginning containing the Hundred and nine acres being the Land that was allotted to the said Joseph Briggs in the division of John A. McKeel's Estate.
