Browne and Susan J. his wife do hereby acknowledge have granted bargained and sold and by these presents do grant bargain sell and convey unto the said Edwards Butts his heirs and assigns a certain tract or parcel of Land containing five hundred acres the same more or less lying and being in the County of Southampton aforesaid and bounded as follows to wit Beginning at a pine a corner of Edwards Butts and Mrs. Jane Briggs Land thence at 89 E 86° to a pine corner of said Butts Land thence at 88 E 66° to a stake thence at 87 E 66° to a red oak a new corner in Henry Briggs line thence at 14 N 19° 50' to a pine a corner of John Magchar's and the Pitman tract thence along said Magchar's line at 68 N 22 E 86° to a pine in the Mercy Branch thence down the various courses of said branch to the Road at a Mrs. Jane Briggs line thence up along said Road at 14 E 39° to the beginning To have and to hold the said tract or parcel of Land with the appurtenances thereto belonging to him the said Edwards Butts his heirs and assigns to the only proper use and behoof of the said Edwards Butts his heirs and assigns forever. And the said Oris A. Browne and Susan J. his wife for themselves their heirs Executors and administrators do hereby Covenant and agree to and with the said Edwards Butts his heirs and assigns that they the said Oris A. Browne and Susan J. his wife and themselves the said tract or parcel of Land and premises with its appurtenances unto him the said Edwards Butts his heirs and assigns against them the said Oris A. Browne and Susan J. his wife their heirs and assigns all person whomsoever shall and lawfully warrant and forever defend In Witness whereof the said Oris A.
