To all men by these presents that whereas Benjamin Morrell of the County of Southampton did Convey to me in trust by a Deed in Writing bearing date the 20th day of November 1832 and duly Recorded in the Clerks Office for said County by which he said Morrell Conveyeth his right in and to a certain tract or parcel of Land situated in Town about one mile across the boundaries of which will be some way apparently the said River of Tidewater also by the said Deed Conveyed his undivided right of his wife Nancy in and to the same abovescribed and assigned to Sally Woodard widow and of John Woodard deceased his right of descent in said decedents Slaves for the purpose of securing the payment of a debt due and owing to Jacob Barnes of said County and whereas said Morrell having by the payment of said debt and the said Jacob Barnes by notice inserting requiring the immediate delivery of the said debt by sale of the above named property whereupon I assented the time and place of Sale agreeable to the terms of the said Deed in Trust and gave on this 23rd day of March 1832 Sold at auction the said Land and also interest in the Slaves described as aforesaid and the said Jacob Barnes then and there became the highest bidder for the Land and interest in and to the said Slaves for which bid he gave two hundred dollars and in consideration of which I do hereby Convey all the title interest and estate which was Conveyed to me by the said in Trust aforesaid in and to both the above named Land and interest in the said Slaves to him the said Jacob Barnes his heirs and assigns forever To have and to hold the said Land and interest in the said Slaves and every part and parcel thereof free from the claim of myself my heirs and assigns and I do by these presents warrant and defend against all who shall ever claim either Land or interest in the said Slaves under or by me In witness whereof I have so, unto it, my hand and affixed my seal on this 23rd day of March 1832.
