This Indenture made this 20 day of Aug^r 1757 in the year of our Lord one Thousand Eight hundred and Forty two Between Hannet Bailey of the County of Southampton and Parish of Netley of the one part and John Holman of the same County and Parish of the other part Witnesseth that the said Hannet Bailey for and on her account of the Sum of Six dollars good and lawful money of Virginia to her on hand paid by the said John Holman the receipt whereof the said Hannet Bailey do acknowledge her self fully and properly satisfied and paid hath granted bargained sold aliened enfeoffed and confirmed and by these presents doth grant bargain and sell unto the said John Holman his heirs and assigns forever one certain tract or parcel of land and premises situate lying and being in the County aforesaid containing by estimation two acres be the same more or less and bounded as follows to wit. Beginning at the Centre of the road called Proctors Road at the Corner of John Holman's five running Eastward to a Stob at the fence side a corner thence South to a Postwood tree standing a Corner thence West to the said Proctor's Road thence North along said Road to the beginning. Together with all houses and houses hold buildings yards gardens or other ways waters and other tenements whatso ever belonging or in any wise appertaining therunto. To have and to hold the said Land and premises to him and to his heirs forever And the said Hannet Bailey for herself her heirs &c. do hereby these presents warrant and grant to and to each the said John Holman his heirs and assigns that she will by these presents warrant and defend forever defend all right title claim or demand of any person or persons claiming or demanding the same or any part or parcel thereof. This Indenture made the 14. Day of August in the year of our Lord one thousand Eight hundred and thirty two. Between Joshua Norton and Eliza Matilda his wife of the County of Suffolk and the One part and Joseph Willens of the said County of the other part. Witness that the said Joshua Norton and Eliza Matilda his wife, in Consideration of the Sum of One hundred and twenty dollars of lawful money of this Commonwealth to them in hand paid by the said Joseph Willens also of the said County and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged. Have bargained and sold and by these presents do and each of them doth bargain and sell unto the said Joseph Willens his heirs and assigns a certain parcel of Land containing Sixty five acres be the same more or less together with all the houses ways and water courses and hereditaments thereto Viz On the east by the Round Hill Road and the South by the Land of John Xand on the West by Fitzgibbon's Swamp and on the North by the Land of William Brown belonging or appertaining or to be the same uses and enjoyed or accepted reputed taken or enjoyed as parcel parcel or number thereof or as belonging to the same or any part thereof or parcel
