

Witness of a last duly executed and of Record in the Clerk's Office of the aforesaid County of Southampton the aforesaid tract or parcel of land containing one hundred and twenty six acres and a square as is marked and bounded as follows Beginning at a Cypress standing in the run of the Cedar Swamp in Josephus Warden's line from thence adjoining the lands of Josephus Warden Esq. to Cape Parker and thence and on the South by Black Water River a distance of the time and place of Sale having been given ten days previous thereto in conformity to the said sales when the said William Warden became the purchaser of the whole tract of one hundred and twenty six acres aforesaid with the reservation there mentioned for the sum of One hundred and ten dollars. This Indenture therefore further Witnesseth that the said Jacob H. Duck and Uriah Rawls Executors as aforesaid, as well for and in consideration of the premises aforesaid as of the sum of one dollar to them in hand paid by the said Warden the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted bargained and sold alone conveyed and confirmed and by these presents do grant bargain sell alone convey confirm to the said William Warden, the said tract or parcel of land before mentioned and described and which was sold at public auction as aforesaid. To have and to hold the said tract or parcel of land with the tenements hereditaments and all and singular thereto premises and appurtenances before mentioned except the reserves aforesaid unto the said William Warden free from the claim or claims demand or demands of them the said Jacob H. Duck and Uriah Rawls or either of them their or either of their heirs shall never and do warrant and for ever defend as Executors and by virtue of the writ aforesaid and no more. In Witness whereof the said Jacob H. Duck and Uriah Rawls as Executors aforesaid have hereunto set their hands and seals the day first as of just above written.

Davidson's This Indenture made this first day of August in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and thirty two between William Warden and James his wife of the County of Northampton in the State of Virginia of the one part and Uriah Rawls of the County of Northampton in the State of Virginia of the other part. Witnesseth that the said William Warden and Jane his wife for and in consideration of the sum of One dollar to them in hand paid by the said Uriah Rawls at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged that the said William Warden and Jane his wife have granted bargained and sold and by these presents do and each of them doth grant bargain and sell unto the said Uriah Rawls his heirs and assigns a certain tract or parcel of Land lying and being in the aforesaid County of Southampton marked and bounded as follows Beginning at a Cypress standing in the run of the Cedar Swamp in Josephus Warden's line from thence adjoining the lands of Josephus Warden Esq. to Cape Parker and thence and on the South by Black Water River containing one hundred and twenty six acres more or less (Reserving however the life estate of Samuel Warden
