Savage of the same County of the other part. Witnesseth that the said Thomas C. and Martha his wife for and in consideration of the sum of Eight hundred dollars of lawful money of the United States to them in hand paid by the said David R. Savage the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have given granted bargained and sold and by these presents do give grant bargain sell and confirm unto the said David R. Savage his heirs and assigns a certain tract of parcel of Land lying and being in the County aforesaid containing by estimation One hundred and forty acres be the same more or less and bounded as follows to wit Beginning on the West side of a Cottony River at the head of a Broad branch or gully, down the meanders of the said branch or gully to a Cottony River, thence down the meanders of the said River to a River line thence south said line to a Corner tree, thence along Brown's line to a Corner tree, thence along Vaughan's line thence along said Vaughan's line to a Hickory tree thence down the said line to a Corner, thence to a Cottony River thence along the said river to the beginning. With all and singular the appurtenances to the said tract of parcel of Land and premises belonging or in anywise appertaining to the said David R. Savage his heirs and assigns. To the only proper use and behoof of him the said David R. Savage his heirs and assigns. In wit: And the said Thomas C. Jones and Martha his wife for themselves their heirs Executors and administrators do hereby consent and agree to and coveit the said David R. Savage his heirs and assigns that they will warrant and forever defend the right and title to the before mentioned tract of parcel of Land and premises with the appurtenances unto him the said David R. Savage his heirs Executors administrators and assigns against themselves the said Thomas C.
