This Indenture made this 30th of August 1832 Between Benjamin Lamb of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia of the first part and John R. Edwards of the second part and Jeremiah C. Egle John Blair and Thomas R. Gray Trustees of the Attorney Indians of the third part Witness that the said Benjamin Lamb being indebted to the said John R. Cobb John Blair and Thomas R. Gray Trustees as aforesaid in the sum of Eight hundred and forty Eight dollars and 64^{cs} by Bond bearing date the 1st day of March 1832 the said Lamb being for the purchase of a part of the Indian Land and being the same purchased by Giles Kidd and transferred to the said Lamb and the said Lamb being anxious to secure the said sum of money to the said Trustees here for the satisfaction of two dollars to him hereunder specified by the said John R. Edwards at or before the execution and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby granted hereunder sold and conveyed to the said Edwards at the right title interest claim or demand of him the said Benjamin Lamb in or to the said Lane his heirs Executors administrators or assigns or any person claiming by or through him the said Land to him the said Edwards his heirs Executors &c forever Upon Trust Nevertheless that if the said Lamb shall cease and fail to pay or cause to be paid to the said Trustees or their Successors when he shall be thereto required the aforesaid sum of Eight hundred and forty Eight dollars and 64^{cs} with the interest &c that may accrue thereon then this indenture to be void but on his failing to do so when required by the said Trustees or their Successors then the said Edwards shall and he is hereby empowered to advertise the said Land for sale giving thirty days notice thereof in one of the public papers within the State and also advertising it at three or more of the most public places in the County of Southampton for so much time as he may see fit to sell the same for Cash or Credit as he may be directed by the said Trustees or their Successors and after paying the said Debt interest &c pay over the balance to the said Lamb his heirs assigns and the said Edwards covenants to and with the said Lamb that when he shall have paid and satisfied the aforesaid Debt interest and cost of this deed he the said Edwards will release and reconvey the same to him the said Lamb his heirs assigns.
