Know all men by these presents that we George G. Gray and Elias Summerville are held and firmly
 bound unto John Floyd Esq. Governor of the Commonwealth of Virginia in the just and full sum
 of one thousand Dollars to be paid to the said Governor and his Successors for the use of the Common-
 wealth To the payment whereof we are and only to be made we bind ourselves our heirs, Exors &
 assigns jointly and severally firmly by these presents sealed with our seals and dated the 17th day
 of September 1832 The Condition of the above obligation is such that when in the
 Court of Southampton County have appointed the above bound George G. Gray Commissioner
 of the Revenue for said County for the Term of one year at out of the said George G. Gray
 shall faithfully perform the duties of the said Office during the said term then the above obligation
 to be void or else to remain in full force and virtue.

 within and paid by the said Richmond Edwards the receipt whereof is her day acknowledged
 grant bargain sell and confirm unto the said Richmond Edwards her heirs and assigns forever
 One certain tract or parcel of land containing by Survey 113¹/₂ Acres lying and being in
 the lower part of Northway Parish Southampton County It also being One half of the part
 of their father's tract of land which was sold at public auction for a division amongst
 him and Eunice Edwards became the purchase and is bounded as follows To wit
 Beginning at a large pine in the Cedar Swamp or Corner between the old line down
 this tract thence S 68¹/₂ E 90 poles along the line between the old line and this tract
 pine post in the Cornfield at Corner between this tract and Eunice Edwards' half in
 the old line down thence S 11¹/₂ E 17¹/₂ poles to a line of pine posts to the old line then
 a line of marked trees the line between this tract and Eunice Edwards' half to a black
 gum or corner in the Shalobury between Eunice Edwards and Richmond Edwards in
 Commonwealth's line thence down the run of the Shalobury the main course thereof 22 poles to
 the Cedar Swamp thence up the Cedar Swamp the main course thereof 22 poles to the
