This Indenture made the 28th day of August in the year of our Lord One Thousand Eight
 Hundred and thirty two by and between Erville Edwards and Catharine Edwards his wife
 of the County and State of Virginia of the one part, and Jonas Edwards of the County and State
 aforesaid of the other part. Witnesseth that the said Erville Edwards and Catharine his
 wife for and in consideration of the sum of four hundred and twenty five dollars to them
 in hand paid by the said Jonas Edwards at or before the making and delivery of these presents
 the receipt whereof they the said Erville Edwards and Catharine his wife do hereby acknowledge
 and themselves to be lawfully indebted Contented and paid that parties Benjamin Sales
 alone and confirmed and by these do go and Benjamin Sales alone and confirmed and by these
 said Jonas Edwards his heirs and assigns forever as certain tract or parcel of land
 lying in the County of Southampton aforesaid and parish of Abbeville containing and
 bounded and situated as follows to wit a half acre more or less and bounded as follows to wit
 at a point first a corner of said land and Benjamin Edwards and standing in a line
 Edwards line thence a line of marked trees a divided line between said land and along
 Edwards to a Hickory standing in said Edwards line thence along a line Edwards line
 to Thomas Moultrie's line to a gum standing in the State of North Carolina a corner of said land
