This Indenture made this 28th day of August in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and thirty two by and between Everett Edwards and Catharine Edwards his wife of the County and State of Virginia of the one part and Jonas Edwards of the County and the aforesaid of the other part. Witnesseth that the said Everett Edwards and Catharine his wife for and in consideration of the sum of four hundred and twenty five dollars to them in hand paid by the said Jonas Edwards at or before the concluding and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof they the said Everett Edwards and Catharine his wife do hereby acknowledge and themselves to be bound unto the said Covenants and purdue such grants bargains and alimer and confirmes and by these do grant bargains sell alien and confirm unto the said Jonas Edwards his heirs and assigns forever as certain tract or parcel of land lying in the County of Southampton aforesaid and parish of Oldemay containing one hundred and sixteen and a half acres more or less and bounded as follows to wit beginning at a point first a corner of said land and Ruthmin Edwards and Standing in standing Edwards line thence a line of marked trees a divided line between said land and along Edwards to a Hickory standing in said Edwards line thence along said Edwards line to some Marshes line to a gum standing in the Slat of Roads a corner of said land.
