Joseph Pittor the receipt whereof as he duly acknowledged having given grant bargain and sell
and sold and by these presents do give grant bargain and sell unto the said Joseph
Pittor and his heirs & Call any right title claim and interest in the Mill and Mill seat
and all appurtenances belonging thereto Containing two acres of Land the said Mill
seat lying and being in the County of Southampton and a crop Tarepsw on and the
right title claim and interest To have and to hold the said Mill together with

Nicholas and Mary This wife of the County of Southampton of the one part and George
Nicholas of the same County of the other part. Whereas Robert Nicholas died by his last will
and Testament devised all his lands at the Cross Roads and Taylor's Old Duns to be equally divided
between his sons Robert and George Nicholas at the time when his son Robert becomes
of age And whereas it is mutually agreed between the said Robert Nicholas and George
Nicholas both of whom are of lawful age that the land contained in the bounds
herein after mentioned shall be appropiated and set apart to the said George Nicholas
