Brooks his Executors administrators and assigns forever and the said Peter Brooks for himself his heirs Executors and administrators the said Willis and Stephen Arney unto the said H. Brooks his Executors administrators and assigns against the claims of him the said P. Brooks his Executors and administrators and against the claim or claims of all and every person or persons who ever shall and will demand and require from them by these presents.
