

of August 1832 by Indenture bearing date the 19th of November 1831 and admitted to Record in the
 Clerk's Office of the County of Southampton on the 22nd of November 1831. and conveyed the said
 Jesse Drury all his interest in the whole both real and personal of Thomas Gray who before
 deceased to him by the last will of the said Thomas Gray dec^d all his interest in the
 plantation adjoining the Lands of William Pasham in the County of Sussex known as the
 Spring Swamp plantation and in the tract of Land on which the late Thomas Gray
 resided in the County of Southampton together with sundry articles of personal property
 as expressed in the said Dec^d of Record aforesaid in Trust for the use of & well being
 and Authority to the said Jesse Drury that if the said Edward Gray should die
 of and in the payment of the said debt when it shall become due then the said
 Drury shall after advertising the same and the time and place of Sale for fifteen days at some
 public place proceed to sell the said property therein conveyed or so much thereof as shall be
 necessary to pay the debt or such part thereof as may be due and unpaid and the expenses
 that may attend the execution of said Trust if the said Gray should fail to discharge
 the said Bond agreeable to the Tenor and effect thereof whenever after such default the said
 Oris A Brown should require a Sale thereof to be made and whereas the said Edward Gray
 having failed to pay the said debt agreeable to the Tenor and effect of the said Bond and the
 said Oris A Brown having in consequence thereof requires a Sale of the said interest
 in the Lands aforesaid to be made for the purpose aforesaid the said Jesse Drury in execution
 of the said Trust after giving fifteen days (and more) notice of the time and place and
 terms of Sale agreeable to the stipulation of said Dec^d of Trust did on the 17th of September
 at the town of Jerusalem the same being Monday expose to Sale at public auction to the
 highest bidder for ready money the said interest in the lands aforesaid and all the whole to wit
 the said Thomas R Gray he came the purchaser of the said interest in the land aforesaid
 by bidding therefor the sum of Two hundred and twenty three dollars which was the
 highest Bid made for the same and that sum he has paid back to the said Jesse
 Drury Now this Indenture Witnesseth that the said Jesse Drury Husband in and to
 of the said sum of Two hundred and twenty three dollars which he has received from the
 said Thomas R Gray as above stated has granted bargained and sold and by these pre-
 sent doth grant bargain and sell and convey unto the said Thomas R Gray his heirs &
 assigns the same interest in the said Lands in the said Conveyance mentioned and
 described To have and to hold the same interest aforesaid with the appurtenances
 thereto belonging and all title and interest of the said Jesse Drury then and the
 said Gray his heirs and assigns to him and their heirs and assigns forever and the
 said Jesse Drury for him of his heirs Executors and assigns hereby Remits he and
 unto the said Gray his heirs and assigns that the 100.00 forever is vacant and depen-
 ding to the said Thomas R Gray his heirs and assigns against the claim of him
 the said Jesse Drury and all persons claiming the same or any part thereof by him
 through or under him the said Jesse Drury Trustee as aforesaid but against the claim of his
