 This Indenture was made by the wife of Lewis C. Gray and Louisa P. Hutchinson and  
 Samuel Polkinton the 10<sup>th</sup> instant and a witness to these presents and a copy filed for the  
 County aforesaid the 15<sup>th</sup> day of October 1832 The said Indenture was entered upon the  
 proceedings of the day

To be James Rochester etc

This Indenture made this 17<sup>th</sup> day of September in the year 1832 Between Thomas R.  
 Gray of the first part & Leulon R. Edwards of the second part and John Virginian of the third part.  
 Witnesseth that the Said Gray being indebted to the Said Virginian in the sum of Two hundred &  
 dollars for money paid and advances by the Said Virginian for the Said Gray as also in other  
 sums of money due to the Said Virginian and the Said Gray about having become the endorser of  
 the Said Gray's note to the Bank at Petersburg for the sum of Five hundred dollars  
 now the Said T. R. Gray being desirous to secure to the Said Virginian the payment of the  
 debt aforesaid and for and in consideration of the sum of One dollar to him in hand paid to or  
 before the issuing and delivery of this instrument by the Said Leulon R. Edwards the receipt  
 whereof is hereby acknowledged shall hereby grant his said bargains sold and conveyed to the  
 Said Edwards his heirs Executors and all the right title interest claims and demands of them  
 the Said Thomas R. Gray in and to the lands of Thomas Gray deceased also the interest of  
 the Said Gray in the lands of the Spring Swamp plantation in the County of Suffolk and  
 the interest of the Said Gray in the lands on which the late Capt. Thomas Gray resided  
 in the County of Southampton it being the sum and all the interest in the aforesaid land  
 purchased by the Said Gray at public sale of Isle Bequia Trustee to a One hundred &  
 Gray for the benefit of Oris A. Brown son of Thomas Gray deceased as of the time of  
 Said Bequia Trustee as aforesaid the Said Thomas R. Gray will appear it being  
 of the sum due of this indenture to have and to hold the aforesaid granted premises  
 or intended to be granted to him the Said Edwards his heirs Executors & C. against the  
 claim of him the Said Thomas R. Gray his heirs &c or the claim of all and every person  
 claiming by or through him upon trust nevertheless of the Said Gray shall well and  
 truly pay to the Said Virginian the aforesaid sum of money whom he shall be then  
 owing and shall have him self the Said Virginian in the aforesaid security shall  
 be endorsed to the Bank aforesaid him this instrument to be true and valid and in the  
 failure in all or either of the above named events and contracts the Said Edwards is  
 hereby authorized and required on giving thirty days notice thereof by public advertisement  
 in one of the most publick newspapers of this Commonwealth except otherwise di-  
 rected in writing by the Said Thomas R. Gray in which case he may give only the  
 usual notice proceed to sell the Said granted premises on such terms as he may be  
 directed as to the payment thereof by the Said Virginian and after paying the Said  
 Virginian the debt aforesaid or such part as may then be due pay over the balance to the  
 Said Gray his heirs or assigns and the Said Edwards' Community to and with the partners  
 faithfully to execute the Said Trust as also stipulated in the aforesaid of the partners  
 have this day first written and signed and delivered the same in presence of
