Trustee or his in case of his death, for his legal personal representative or representatives
at any time after the 25th day of September next to make Sale of the Estate and property
aforesaid or any part thereof to the highest bidder, for Cash bearing first and after the time
place and terms of Sale for two weeks at the least by advertisement posted up in two or more of
the most public places in the County aforesaid and out of the proceeds in the first place to
discharge all legal and usual Costs and expenses attending the Sale and conveyance in the
Second place to pay and satisfy the debt and entrees herein first noted to be due to the
party of the third party, or to much as shall be in arrear at the time and in the third place
the Surplus if any to be paid to the Said Simmins or his Executor and the Said Thomas Fin-
mont both hereby Covenant with the Said Testator R. Edwards that he is possessed of an
absolute estate of the Simple in all the property aforesaid and that he will forever dis-
mant the title hereby Conveyed, against all persons whatsoever. In Testimony whereof

be recovered by suits which I am now about to bring to recover the Money or monies

for the same to the purchaser or purchasers and I hereby authorise my said
Attorney for me and in my name to give grant execute and deliver good and suffi-
cient deeds of Warrant to the purchaser or purchasers of the said Land and
