So one thousand Eight hundred and thirty two between Edwin Barnes of the first part
Edwards Peter Edwards of the second part and Jesse Drury of the third part all of the County of
Southampton and State of Virginia Witnesseth that the said Edwin Barnes for and
in Consideration of the Sum of One hundred and twenty seven dollars and Eighteen
Cents which said Sum is due from the said Edwin Barnes to the said Peter
Edwards by Bond bearing date as in these presents as well as all other monies
which may be due and owing from the said Edwin Barnes to the said Peter Edwards by
means of any dealings transfer of debt or paper what ever as also for and in Consideration
of the Sum of One dollar to him in hand paid by the said Jesse Drury the receipt whereof
the said Edwin Barnes doth hereby acknowledge hath granted bargained and sold
and by these presents doth hereby grant bargain and sell convey and make over
unto the said Jesse Drury and his heirs forever all his right and interest
in the following property to wit his present Crop of Cotton supposed to be ten
thousand pounds and his present Crop of Corn supposed to be Eighty Bunches and all other
Crop of every description belonging to him the said Edwin Barnes. To have and to
hold with all the right and interest of the said Edwin Barnes herein conveyed
intended to be conveyed to him the said Jesse Drury his heirs and assigns forever
upon this Special Trust to wit that the said Jesse Drury upon being
therein required by the aforesaid Peter Edwards shall proceed to sell all the right
and interest of the said Edwin Barnes to the above named property hereby conveyed
or intended to be conveyed after advertising the time and place in the said County of
Southampton for fifteen days previous at some one or more public houses or other
for cash and out of the money arising from the said Sale in the first place
pay and satisfy all cost attending the said Sale as well as the expenses attending the
said conveyance and then pay off the debt aforesaid with interest as well as all
other monies which may appear to be due and owing from the said Edwin Barnes
to the said Peter Edwards by means of any dealings transfer of debt or paper what ever
and the Surrender of any pay to the said Edwin Barnes and the said Edwin Barnes
for himself his heirs Executors and administrators the right and title of the said property
unto the said Jesse Drury his heirs and assigns forever with hereby warrant
