Barnes This Indenture made and entered into this tenth day of October in the year of our Lord  
one thousand Eight hundred and Sixty two between Edwin Barnes of the first part  
Peter Edwards of the second part and Jeph Dury of the third part all of the County of  
Southampton and State of Virginia Whereas it is agreed between the said Edwin Barnes and  
in Consideration of the sum of One hundred and Twenty Seven dollars and Eighteen  
cents which said sum is due from the said Edwin Barnes to the said Peter  
Edwards by Bond bearing date such these presents as well as all other monies  
which may be due and owing from the said Edwin Barnes to the said Peter Edwards by  
means of any dealing transfer of debt or paper whatsoever as also for and in Consideration  
of the sum of One dollar to him unconditionally the said Jeph Dury the receipt whereof  
the said Edwin Barnes doth hereby acknowledge to have granted bargained and sold  
and by these presents delivereth by grant, Bargain and Sell, Convey and make over  
unto the said Jeph Dury and his heirs forever all his right and interest  
in the following property unto his present Crop of Cotton Supposed to be six  
thousand pounds and his present Crop of Corn Supposed to be Eighty bushels and all my  
Crop of Every description belonging to him the said Edwin Barnes To have and to  
hold with all the right and interest of the said Edwin Barnes herein Conveyed  
intended to be Conveyed to him the said Jeph Dury his heirs and assigns forever  
upon this Special Trust Marshall's that the said Jeph Dury upon being  
thereby required by the aforesaid Peter Edwards Shall proceed to sell all the right  
and interest of the said Edwin Barnes to the above named party hereby Conveyed  
or intended to be Conveyed after advertising the same aforesaid in the said County of  
Southampton for a space of ten days previous at some one or more publick houses in that  
place and out of the money arising from the sale of the said estate as well as all  
pay and satisfy all cost attending the said sale as well as the expence attending the  
said Conveying and then pay off the debt aforesaid with interest as well as all  
other monies which may appear to be due and owing from the said Edwin Barnes  
to the said Peter Edwards by means of any dealing transfer of debt or paper whereby  
and the simple of any pay to the said Edwin Barnes and the said Edwin Barnes  
for himself his heirs Executors and administrators the right and title of the said property  
unto the said Jeph Dury his heirs and assigns forever to be held by him in trust for the said
