James To Jones Know all men by these presents that I James Jones of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia for and in consideration of the natural love and affection which I bear to my beloved daughter Nancy Jones and Mary Ann Jones, both of the same County and State aforesaid as well as for the further consideration of one dollar to me in hand paid by the said Nancy Jones and Mary Ann Jones, at or before the making and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged. Have given and granted and by these presents do give and grant unto the said Nancy Jones and Mary Ann Jones to be equally divided between them all my right title and interest in all the personal estate of my Mother in Law Mary Jones deceased which estate consists of negroes and other personal property I have and to hold the said right title and interest of said Negroes and other personal estate unto them the said Nancy Jones and Mary Ann Jones their Executors administrators and assigns forever and I the said James Jones for myself my Executors and administrators the right title and interest in the said personal Estate of my Mother in Law Mary Jones deceased of negroes and other personal Estate unto the said Nancy Jones and Mary Ann Jones their Executors administrators and assigns against the claim of James Jones his Executors administrators and against the claim or claims of all and every person or persons whatsoever that law will allow and aid for and defend by these presents
