This Indenture made this Eleventh day of October in the year of our Lord one thousand
 eight hundred and thirty two by and between Thomas Brown of the County of Lafayette and
 State of Mississippi of the first part, and Joel Prefers of the County of Southampton and State
 of Virginia of the second part. Witnesseth that for and in consideration of the sum of
 Three hundred dollars current money of Virginia in hand paid by the said Joel Prefers
 to the said Thomas Brown the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged by the said Thomas
 Brown, he the said Thomas Brown, hath given granted conveyed and confirmed and
 by these presents doth give grant convey and confirm to the said Joel Prefers the
 him his heirs all right title and interest which he the said Thomas Brown hath law
 certain tract or parcel of Land situate lying and being in the County of Southampton which
 was devised to him the said Thomas Brown by the last will and Testament of his
 father Jesse Brown which said last will and Testament is dated on the 26th day of
 September in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and seventy two and
 admitted to probate by the County Court of Southampton on the 8th day of November next
 year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and eighty one. To have and to hold
 the said tract or parcel of Land to him the said Joel Prefers and his heirs forever
 the title to which said tract or parcel of Land, he the said Thomas Brown doth and
 will forever warrant and defend against him the said Thomas Brown and all
