Holding the said Shamm Jordan seisin sole for the title and interest which he promised at the time of selling the said land to me and no other. This Indenture made and entered into this 16<sup>th</sup> day of May in the year of our Lord one thousand Eight hundred and thirty two. Between Valentine Simmons of the County of Southampton State of Virginia of the first part and Richard Warden of the said County and State of the second part and Augustin Pope of the said County and State of the third part Witnesseth that whereas the said Valentine Simmons then do jointly indebted to said Augustin Pope for the sum of Eighty six dollars and 74 cents due by bond bearing even date with these presents. Now this Indenture further Witnesseth that said Valentine Simmons being willing and desirous to have with the said Augustin Pope the above mentioned debt and interest thereon and also for and in consideration of the sum of One dollar to him in hand paid by the said Richard Warden the said Valentine Simmons hath granted bargained and sold and by these presents doth grant bargain and sell unto the said Richard Warden and to his heirs and assigns forever the following property to wit two bedsteads and furniture one loom and gear one wooden wheel and chest five chains two pots one saw one chest one grubbing hoe four axes two sawing hoes three plough hoes one Butler two carts and one pair of wheels one bay horse four head of cattle fifteen hundred pounds of fodder and twenty barrels of Corn of the present Crop. Thus now growing also two sters and seven ten sheats. To the said Richard Warden and to his heirs and assigns forever and to and for the following intents use and purposes Viz he the said Richard Warden his Executors administrators or assigns may and shall at any time hereafter being requested by either of the parties to these presents proceed and sell all or so much of the within mentioned property as will pay and satisfy the within debt and interest also all costs of carrying this indenture into effect for ready cash after giving ten days notice at three public places by advertisement at least five miles of the place of sale and the surplus if any of such sale pay unto said Simmons his
