 the one part and Kenech Williamson of the County aforesaid of the other part. Witnesseth
 that the said Benjamin Williamson in consideration of the Sum of Three hundred
 and Eighty dollars to him in hand paid by the said Kenech Williamson the receipt
 whereof is hereby acknowledged have bargained and sold to the said Kenech William-
 sons his heirs and assigns a certain tract or piece of Land Situated lying on the
 Southampton County on the South Side of the three Creeks containing by a true Survey
 more or less acres the same more or less and bounded as follows to wit Beginning
 at a white oak a corner between the said Williamson and said Williamson thence
 along his line N 7 E 265 poles to the three Creeks wh said Creek as it measured
 to John J. Adams line thence along his line S 7 N 132 poles to a pine N 1/2 E 142
 poles to a pine bush a corner to the said Benjamin Williamson thence
 S 1/2 E 118 1/2 poles to a white oak at 47 E 38 1/2 to a white oak at 66 E 14 poles
