shall faithfully perform the duties of the said Office during the said Term then

himself his heirs and assigns a Certain Tract or piece of Land Situated lying on the
ampton County on the South Side of the three Creeks containing by a true Survey
more or less five acres be the same more or less and bounded as follows to wit Beginning
at a white oak a corner between the said Williamson and said Williams thence
along his line N 7th E 265 poles to the three Creeks wh said Creek at it measured
to John J. Williams line thence along his line S 7th N 132 poles to a pine bush
line S 1st E 88 poles to a white oak at 47th E 38 poles to a white oak at 66th E 14 poles
at 67th 21st E 18 poles to the beginning To have and to hold the said aforesaid Tract
of Land together with all the appurtenances thereto belonging for the life of the said
