James to William This Indenture made and entered into on the 15th day of October in the year of our Lord one thousand Eight hundred and twenty two by and between Jacob Barnes of the first part and William Wilson of the second part each party of the County of Southampton in the State of Virginia This Indenture Witnesseth that for and in consideration of the sum of Five hundred and fifty dollars to him the said Jacob Barnes in hand paid by the above named William Wilson at and before the making and delivery of these presents the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged by him the said Jacob Barnes upon which receipt I the said Jacob Barnes have bargained and sold and do by these presents grant bargain and sell and convey to him the said William Wilson his heirs and assigns the tract of Land which I the said Jacob Barnes lately purchased at a public Sale by Thomas Barnes under Trust for the benefit of me the said Jacob Barnes formerly owned by Samuel Woodard dec'd by and under the Cross Keys on the County of said and said to contain about one hundred acres this matter not whether more or less as to this purchase I have and to hold the said tract of Land and every part thereof to him the said William Wilson his heirs and assigns forever except any right of dower which the present wife of Benjamin Morrell may hereafter have from and by the death of said Morrell except from all other claims or expenses demands whatsover so far as I know or believe hereby warranting and defending against myself my heirs and assigns forever I will keep with me these parts set my hands and affixed my seal the day and year hereunto first before written Signed sealed acknowledged and delivered in presence of
