Johnson This Indenture made this 12th day of October 1832. Between Richard Johnson son of Southampton County Va. of the one part and William Harris of the second part and Abraham Harrison Kidder of Stafford County A.C. and William Evans of Southampton County, Virginia of the third part. Whereas the said Richard Johnson is jointly indebted to the said Abraham Kidder and to the sum of Forty five dollars and Eighty seven cents, bond bearing date Sept. 1830. and to William Evans as follows one note made payable to Jonathan Price C. Harrison dated Sept 17th 1831. for twenty dollars one note made payable to William Evans dated 22nd November 1831. for twenty dollars one note executed to William Evans August 16th 1831. for four dollars and fifty seven cents and one other note executed to William Evans March 29th 1832. for quantum dollars and sixty three cents. To be paid on the first day of January 1833. which debt, each legal, entire the said Richard Johnson is owing and owing to said Now this Indenture Witnesseth that for and in consideration of one dollar of lawful money of Virginia to the said Richard Johnson in witness paid by the said William Harris on at and before the sealing and delivering of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged by the said Richard Johnson hath given granted bargained sold aliened released and confirmed and by these presents doth give grant bargain sell alien release and confirm to the said William Harris on and to his heirs and assigns forever the following property Viz one Quarter of one Acre and half one Cent and whole two rods and four tenths all the Bushland and hedges for many farming utensils Spaulow traps three Sharp fowls six hives and the said Richard Johnson for terms of his life is Executor and administrator doth hereby commit promise and agree to and with the said William Harris her heirs Executors and assigns forever in manner and form following Viz the said Richard Johnson his heirs Executors and administrators all the personal property hereby coming to and the said William Harris on his heirs Executors administrators and assigns as and all persons what ever shall and did claim and for ever defend by these presents. Upon Trust Nevertheless that the said William Harris on his heirs Executors and assigns should permit the said Richard Johnson to remain in quiet and peaceable possession of the said personal property hereby conveyed, and take the profits thereof to his own use until default is made in the payment of the said sum of the Bonds above recited either in whole or any part. and then when the further Trust that he or his heirs Executors
