This Indenture made this 12th day of October 1832. Between Richard Johnson of Southampton County Va. of the one part and William Harris of the second part and Abraham Keldick of Stafford County A.C. and William Owens of Southampton County, Virginia of the third part. Whereas the said Richard Johnson is justly indebted to the said Abraham Keldick on the sum of Forty five dollars and Eighty seven cents, bond bearing date Sept. 1830. and to William Owens as follows one Note made payable to Jonathan Price C. Harrison dated Sept 17th 1831. for twenty dollars one Note made payable to William Owens dated August 1st 1831. for twenty dollars one Note executed to William Owens August 16th 1831. for four dollars and fifty seven cents and one other Note executed to William Owens March 29th 1832. for twenty dollars and sixty three cents. To be paid on the first day of January 1833. which debts, debts legal, contract the said Richard Johnson is owing and desires to secure Now this Indenture Witnesseth that for and in consideration of one dollar of lawful money of Virginia to the said Richard Johnson in witness whereof the said William Harris on and before the sealing and delivering of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged by the said Richard Johnson hath given granted bargained sold aliened released and confirmed unto these presents date given grant bargained sold aliened released and confirmed to the said William Harris on and to his heirs and assigns forever the following property Viz one Quarter (all one Cow and calf one Cunt and wheels Trocks and furniture all the Bushland and hedges for miles for many acres of Spaulow hogs three Sharp fow six Hens and the said Richard Johnson for terms of his term Executor and assigns to have and to hold unto the said William Harris on his term Executor, admors and assigns all the Personal property hereby conveyed unto the said William Harris on his term Executor, admors and assigns as and all person what ever shall and at all law Law and for ever defend by these presents. Upon Trust Nevertheless that the said William Harris on his term Executor and assigns shall permit the said Richard Johnson to remove in quiet and peaceable possession of the said Personal property hereby conveyed, and take the profits thereof to his own use until default is made on the payment of the said sum of the Bonds above named either in whole or any part. and then when the said sum of the Bonds above named
