This Indenture made the 8 day of June in the year 1832 between Thomas R Gray of the
 first part James Garrison of the same part one Fulling Sallahone of the third part Whereas the said Fulling
 Sallahone by his Will dated the 21st of February 1831 made of Record in the Clerk's Office of the County
 of Southampton in Order to secure the payment of Six hundred and one twenty dollars due the said Garrison by
 Bond conveyed to the said Thomas R Gray on Trust the following property To wit One tract and parcel of
 land in the County of Southampton containing by estimation one hundred and twenty six and two thirds
 acres sit being the same conveyed to me by Henry St Bridges as of and the said Mahomed having
 conveyed the following property to Adam called it to the benefit of Thomas and some after
 selling my back of some 5000 & some the said Mahomed doth hereby grant and convey to the
 said grant one hundred acres of Land more or less sit being the tract adjoining the town of Abingdon
 in the County aforesaid also one other tract of Land containing one hundred and fifteen acres be the
 same more or less which lies adjoining the lands of Alexander Mappin in the County aforesaid
 also one other tract of Land containing one hundred and seven times be the same more or
 less lying and being in the County of Northfolk at Mansland also my right and title in and
 in several tract of Land containing three hundred and eighty acres be the same more or
 less lying and being in the County of Southampton on a River near the town
 of Abingdon which was conveyed by me to Adam St Bridges as heretofore and doth hereby of
 William St Bridges dec'd and which is of Record in the County aforesaid also the following
 property from horses to two cattle One yoke of Oxen twenty sheep goats Bonds to the amount
 of two hundred dollars which may be due and payable to the late firm of Mahomed &
 Burson and the said sum of Six hundred and twenty dollars with interest due &
 having been paid and satisfied by the said Mahomed to the said Garrison heretofore the said
 Fulling Sallahone hath requested that the estate conveyed by the said Will of Trust
 to them the said Gray and Garrison in the property therein mentioned be now released to him
 the said F. S. Mahomed. This Indenture therefore witnesseth that for and in Consideration
 of the premises and also for and in Consideration of One dollar to the said Gray and
 Garrison in hand paid by the said F. S. Mahomed before the sealing and delivery of these
 presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged they have released and discharged from
 all their claims and by these presents do fully and absolutely remove release and discharge
 claims into the said Fulling Sallahone his heirs and assigns for ever all the whole
 right title interest claim and demand whatsoever now or hereafter of them the said
 Gray and Garrison in and to the property aforesaid To have and to hold the property
 aforesaid with its appurtenances to the said Fulling Sallahone his heirs and assigns
 forever against the Claim of them the said Garrison and Gray or any one claiming
 by or through them and all persons claiming by or through them any part or parcel of the
 aforesaid property are hereby utterly excluded and barred forever And We Trust that of the
 Parties of the first and second parts to these presents have hereunto set their hands &
 affixed their Seals this day and year first here written
