

This Indenture made this 8th day of June in the year 1832 between Thomas H Gray of the
 first part James Garrison of the second part and Fulling Settakine of the third part Whereas the said Fulling
 Settakine by his Will dated the 21st of February 1831 made Record in the Clerk's Office of the County
 of Southampton in Order to secure the payment of Seven hundred and thirty dollars due the said Garrison by
 said Estate to the said Thomas H Gray in trust to hold him his property until one tract or parcel of
 land in the County of Southampton containing by estimation one hundred and twenty six and two thirds
 acres it being the same Conveyed to me by Henry H Hodges as his and the said Mahone having
 Conveyed the following property to Austin as his Agent for the benefit of him as also some after
 paying his and others debts &c and the said Mahone distributed his land and money to the
 said grantor Mahone in acres of Land nine or less it being the tract adjoining the town of Elbowe
 in the County aforesaid also one other tract of land containing three hundred and fifteen acres the
 same more or less which lies adjoining the lands of Alexander Myrick in the County aforesaid
 also another tract of Land containing one hundred and seven acres be the same more or
 less lying and being in the County of Hartford & Carolina also my right and title in and
 an undivided tract of Land containing three hundred and eighty acres be the same more
 less lying and being in the County of Southampton and attorney Rurid in the name of
 Mahone which was Conveyed by me to Elbow H Hodges as his and distributee of
 William H Hodges dec'd and which is of Rurid in the County aforesaid also the following
 property from horses to deer cattle One yoke of oxen twenty sheep goes Bonds to the amount
 of two hundred dollars which may be due and payable to the late friend of Mahone
 aforesaid and the said sum of six hundred and ninety dollars with interest to be
 paid by the said Mahone to the said Garrison but the said
 Fulling Settakine having requested that the estate Conveyed by the said Will of Trust
 to them the said Gray and Garrison in the property therein mentioned be now retained to them
 the said F J Mahone. This Indenture therefore witnesseth that for and in Consideration
 of the premises and after and in consideration of one dollar to the said Gray and
 Garrison in hand paid by the said F J Mahone before the sealing and delivery of these
 presents the receipt whereof whereby acknowledged they have received a clear and plen-
 tyfull discharge of all their claims and demands whatsoever in law or Equity of them the said
 Gray and Garrison in and to the property aforesaid. To have and to hold the property
 aforesaid with its appurtenances to the said Fulling Settakine his heirs and assigns
 forever against the claim of them the said Garrison and Gray or any one claiming
 by or through them and all persons claiming by or through them any part or parcel of the
 aforesaid property are hereby utterly excluded and barred forever. In witness whereof the
