This Indenture made this 26<sup>th</sup> day of October between the one of us whose name is Thomas  
Eight hundred and thirty two Belvoir Russell Edwards of the County of Southampton  
State of Virginia of the one part and Lewis Womell of the same County and State,  
the other part to witness where that the said Russell Edwards for and in consideration  
of the sum of One hundred and Eighty Seven dollars fifty cents current money of this  
Commonwealth to him in hand given by the said Lewis Womell at or before the taking  
and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged to be  
granted being and sold at once unbroken and confirmed and by these presents  
to the grantor bargained and sold alone in behalf and confirmed unto him the said Lewis  
Womell his heirs and assigns forever One certain tract or parcel of land lying  
and being in the aforesaid County of Southampton and Parish of Saint Luke's contain-<sup>ing</sup>  
nig by Survey Sixty five acres of the same more or less and bounded as follows  
to wit Beginning at a post standing on the side of the road a corner for Many  
Reel in a tree Stephenson's line thence along said tree to another Stephenson's line the  
road to a red oak a corner for Bell and Blaw thence along his line to a loco post  
standing on the side of said Road thence S 77<sup>E</sup> E 140 poles to a point a corner  
at which Dick's line comes S 4<sup>E</sup> 30 poles to an oak a corner for Drury's road thence  
along his line S 85<sup>E</sup> 210 poles to the first station. Together with all right title  
interest claim or demand of in and to the aforesaid tract or parcel of land and premises  
with its appurtenances thereunto belonging or in any wise appertaining To have and to hold  
the above described tract of Land and premises with all and singular its appur-  
tenances thereunto belonging unto him the said Lewis Womell his heirs and assigns forever  
to and for the only proper use and behoef of him the said Lewis Womell his heirs  
and assigns forever. And the said Russell Edwards for himself of his land and  
and a ministrations doth hereby warrant and agree to and with the said  
Lewis Womell his heirs Executors Administrators and assigns that he will by  
these presents warrant and forever defend all the right and title to the  
aforesaid tract or parcel of Land and premises against the claims or demands of him
