 of Joseph Sell to whom or Conveyance was executed by a certain Thomas Richs on the 27th of
 February 1790 and of Records the Clerk's Office of Southampton to answer the payment of
 certain sums of money, then and now due and to be paid by the said Esam Lewis

 sold by his son Robert Richs to Thomas A Hoy as aforesaid as of Record with

 thirty three Between William Briggs Jr and Rebecca his wife of the County of Sussex of the first part
 and Esam Briggs of Southampton County of the second part Witnesseth that the said William
 Briggs Jr and Rebecca his wife in Consideration of Seven hundred and fifty dollars of good
 lawful money of this Commonwealth to them in hand paid by the said Esam Briggs at or
 before the entering and delivery of these presents (the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged
 and by these presents is given and sold with bargain and sale
 have bargained and sold unto the said Esam Briggs his heirs and assigns a certain
 part or parcel of land Situate lying and being in the County of Southampton Containing
 four hundred and fifty acres (be the same more or less) bounded by the lands and tenements
 of William Nicholson on the east a small part of the land of John R Briggs on
 the South a new line at 1 1/4 E. On the west and Barton's Road on the North; it being
 a part of the land devised by the late John Nicholson of Southampton alluded by Commissioners
 to the said William Briggs as a reference to their report made fully shown together with
 all and singular the appurtenances whatsoever to the said land belonging or appertain-
 ing and the reversion and reversionary Remainder and Remains, issues and other rents, profits
 and profits thereof and of every part and parcel thereof. To have and to hold the said
