 belonging to the estate of Thomas Applewhite dec'd North by the lands of Sally Davis and Nancy
 Rice, and East by those of George W. Pate, the other Containing one hundred and twenty acres and
 bounded on the South by the stream called New Creek on the west by the lands of Theophilus
 Pate, and Charles S. Pate, on the North by the lands of George W. Pate, and on the East by
 the lands purchased by the said Mason of Alexander S. Pate, which two parcels of land
 were by Deeds bearing date the 16 day of July 1827. Conveyed by the said Alexander S. Pate
 to the said Henry Harris To have and to hold the said grants & premises with the
 appurtenances to him the said John Y. Mason to him and to his heirs and assigns forever
 and the said Henry Harris & wife Covenants with the said Mason that he shall have
 quiet possession of the premises conveyed and defend a good and perfect title to the same against

 consideration of the sum of two hundred and twenty six dollars and six cents to me and
 hand paid by the said Carr Bladen the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have
 bargained sold aliened and confirmed and by these presents do bargain sell alien and
 confirm unto the said Carr Bladen his heirs and assigns one certain piece of parcel of
 Land lying and being in the County of Northampton and State of Virginia and bounded by
 the lands of William Elliott, Mathias Williams and others it being the tract of Land which
 I purchased of Titus divided and wife and mine, the appurtenances of Long Wharf &c. the
 said tract of Land is supposed to contain one hundred and twenty five acres or there
 more or less To have and to hold the said Land unto the said Carr Bladen
 his heirs and assigns forever. And the said Nicholas Born will for myself
 my heirs Executors and administrators warrant and defend the aforesaid Land
 unto the said Carr Bladen his heirs and assigns firm and against any person or persons
 claiming by title or under me and firm and against all and every other person
 or persons whatsoever unto the said Carr Bladen his heirs and assigns forever
 And the said Nicholas Born doth command and agree to and with the said
 Carr Bladen that I have good right and lawful authority to sell and convey
 aforesaid the said Land and premises with the appurtenances thereto belonging unto
 said Carr Bladen his heirs and assigns forever. In the presence of The said
