 were by Deed bearing date the 16th day of July 1837, Conveyed by the said Alexander P. Peale
 to the said Harry Harris, To have and to hold the said granted premises with the
 appurtenances to him the said John Y. Mason to him and his heirs and assigns forever,
 and the said Harry Harris wife Covenant with the said Mason that he shall have
 quiet possession of the premises Conveyed and defend as good and perfect title to the same against

 both of the State of North Carolina. Whereas it is agreed that the said Nicholas Born for and in
 consideration of the sum of two hundred and thirty six dollars and 25 Cents to me in
 hand paid by the said Carl Warden the receipt whereof I acknowledge acknowledged and
 bargained sold alured and confirmed and by these presents the bargainer shall always and
 forever more hold and keep unto the said Carl Warden his heirs and assigns one certain tract of land of
 land lying and being in the County of Southampton and State of Virginia and bounded
 by the lands of William Abbott Mathew Williams and others it being the tract of land which
 I purchased of Titus Warden and wife and numerous heirs of sum of forty whiteface the
 said tract of land is supposed to contain one hundred and twenty four acres to the
 same more or less To have and to hold the said land and unto the said Carl Warden
 his heirs and assigns forever And I the said Nicholas Born will for myself
 my heirs executors and administrators warrant and defend the aforesaid land
 unto the said Carl Warden his heirs and assigns firm and against any person or persons
 claiming by, through or under me and firm and against all and every other person
 or persons whatsoever unto the said Carl Warden his heirs and assigns forever
 And I the said Nicholas Born doth Covenant and agree to and with the said
 Carl Warden that I have good right and lawful authority to sell and convey as
 aforesaid the said land and premises with the appurtenances thereto belonging unto the
