Know all men that this Indenture made and entered into this 23rd day of September 1832 Between
To Oris at Promiss of the first part Thomas R Gray of the second part and Arthur Middleton
Middletown of the third part all of the County of Southampton, Westchester that the said Oris at Promiss
doth and doeth duly not bearing date this 30th day of July 1832 and the said Arthur
Middletown being bound as Security for the said Oris at Promiss for the sum of seven hundred
and fifty six dollars due to Miles Lawrence by note bearing date the 21st day of March
1831 and the said Oris at Promiss being willing and desirous to secure the payment of
the sum of money aforesaid due the said Middletown all into the interest thereon according
and also to save harmless the said Middletown from all loss damage or inconvenience which
he may sustain in consequence of his Security for the debt aforesaid due Miles E
Lawrence hath for and in consideration of the premises as one of the parties aforesaid
of the sum of One dollar to him the said Oris at Promiss and paid by the said
Thomas R Gray the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged he the said Oris at
Promiss hath given granted bargained and sold and by these presents do give
grant bargain sell and Convey unto the said Thomas R Gray his Executors and
or assigns the following property to wit negro man Elias, Harry, Jepe, Benjamin and
women Suckey and Charlotte, Paddy and Child, Rachel, William and Eliza. To have
and to hold the aforesaid Shares and the increase of the females thereof to have the said
Thomas R Gray, his Executors and or assigns for ever. Upon this Special Condition
that if that of the said Oris at Promiss shall fail to make payment of the debt
due to the said Arthur Middletown with all interest due thereon or whenever the said
Arthur Middletown shall conceive himself to be in danger of suffering or want
of his Security aforesaid it shall and may be lawful for the said Thomas R
Gray or his Executors and or assigns being thereof requested by the said Middletown
his Executors administrators or assigns to make sale of the property aforesaid
at public auction to the highest bidder or so much thereof as shall be sufficient
having first paid the time and place of sale at his own discretion and given
fifteen days notice thereof and out of the moneys arising from the sale which
shall be for cash first pay and satisfy the expensing attending the sale as the said
of Recording this Indenture then pay and satisfy the debt due the said Middletown
and the debt due the said Lawrence for which the said Middletown is bound
