the 19<sup>th</sup> day of December 1832 the said Indenture was entered upon the record

Browne This Indenture made and entered into this 27<sup>th</sup> day of September 1832 Between  
I, Oris A Brown of the first part Thomas R Gray of the second part and Aaron Middletton  
of the third part all of the County of Southampton, Wtshire, that the said Oris A Brown and  
Tome Lawrie to the said Aaron Middletton on the sum of four hundred and twenty  
dollars Dots, Cents, duly note bearing date the 30<sup>th</sup> day of July 1832 and the said Aaron  
Middletton being bound as Security for the said Oris A Brown for the sum of one hundred  
and fifty six dollars due to Mills & Lawrence by note bearing date the 21<sup>st</sup> day of March  
1831 and the said Oris A Brown being willing and desirous to bind the said Aaron  
to the sum of money aforesaid due the said Middletton until the same is recovered  
and also to save him of the said Middletton from all his damages or inconveniences which  
he may sustain in consequence of his Securit for the debt aforesaid due Mills &  
Lawrie hath for and in consideration of the premises and of the further Condi-  
tion of the sum of one dollar to him the said Brown in hand paid by the said  
Thomas R. Gray thereto except otherwise expressly acknowledged by the said Oris A  
Brown which given granted bargained and sold and by these presents doth  
grant bargained sold and Conveyed unto the said Thomas R. Gray his Executors and  
or assigns the following property to wit negro men Ellis, Harry, Jpe Brown, and  
woman Buckley and Charles Pelly and child Rachel, William and Nancy Peller  
and to hold the aforesaid slaves and the increase of the female thereof to him the said  
Thomas R. Gray, his Executors adms or assigns forever Upon this Special Condition  
that if that of the said Oris A Brown, shall fail to make payment of the debt  
due to the said Aaron Middletton which all interest due thereon or otherwise the said  
Aaron Middletton shall consider himself to be in danger of suffering or even  
of his Securit aforesaid it shall and may be lawful for the said Thomas  
Gray or his Execs adms or assigns being then required by the said Middletton  
his Executors adms or assigns to make sale of the property of record  
at public auction to the highest bidder or so much thereof as shall be sufficient  
having first fixed the time and place of sale at his own discretion and given  
fifteen days Notice thereof and out of the monies arising from the sale what  
shall be for costs, just pay and satisfy the expenses attending the sale and the bal-  
of Recovery the Indenture then pay and satisfy the debt due the said Middletton  
and the debt due the said Lawrence for which the said Middletton is security
