And the said Morris A Brown covenants with the said Thomas R Gray that he will deliver up the property aforesaid to be sold when required. And the said Thomas R Gray covenants with the other parties thereto that he will and faithfully discharge the debt aforesaid in kind. Witnesseth that the said Just Jordan and Elizabeth his wife for and in consideration of the sum of One thousand One Hundred and fifty dollars current money of this Commonwealth, to them in hand paid by the said Warden W. Pageant, at or before the executing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged Have granted bargained sold aliened enfeoffed and confirmed and by these presents do and each of them doth hereby grant bargain sell alien enfeoff and confirm unto the said Warden W. Pageant his heirs and assigns forever, One Certain Tract or parcel of Land situate lying and being in the aforesaid County of Southampton and Parish of Saint Charles, Containing by a late Survey Three hundred and thirty ^{three} acres be the same more or less and bounded as follows to wit.
