and Elizabeth his wife for and in consideration of the sum of One thousand One Hundred
and Sixty Dollars current money of this Commonwealth to them in hand paid by the said Warder H.
Bryant at or before the making and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby
acknowledged has granted bargained sold alienated and confirmed and by these
presents do and each of them doth hereby grant, bargain sell alienate and confirm unto him
the said Warder H. Bryant his heirs and assigns forever One certain tract or parcel of land
situate lying and being in the aforesaid County of Southampton and Parish of Saint Luke
containing by a late Survey Three hundred and forty acres to the dimensions or less and
more as follows to w^t. Beginning at a Black Gum standing in the upper swamp
a corner of Holliday Reel in a Mazy Thicket line stones along said Reels line 149
11 34 poles to a pine stump thence 127 E. 23 poles to another pine stump thence 167 p. W.
126 poles to a pine thence 237 p. W 134 poles to a chestnut standing near the head of
a small branch a corner of Thomas Tursons in said Reels line stones along Tursons
