This Indenture made and entered into this 27th day of October 1832 Between John
Vaughan, of the first part, Luiton R Edwards of the second part, and Nicholas McNeill
of the third part. Whereas the said John Vaughan is partly indebted unto the said Nicholas
McNeill in the sum of thirty dollars by note bearing equal date with these presents,
and being willing and desirous to secure the pay of said note of which he is and in Commis-
sion of the premises and of the executor's sum of one dollar to him in hand paid by the
said Luiton R Edwards the receipt whereof whereby a true copy of the same given and granted
herein and sold and by these presents doth give, grant bargain sell and Confirm unto
the said Luiton R Edwards his heirs and assigns forever all his the said John V.
Vaughan's interest in the lands whereof his father John Vaughan died seized
lying and being in the County of Southampton. To have and to hold the interest hereby
conveyed or intended to be conveyed unto him the said Luiton R Edwards his heirs and
assigns upon the following trust that is to say that if the said John Vaughan
shall fail to pay or cause to be paid to the said Nicholas McNeill his Executors
or assigns the aforesaid sum of thirty dollars with the interest due thereon and all costs
allowing these presents on or before the 27th day of October 1833. that then or at any time
thereafter it shall and may be lawful for the said Luiton R Edwards to make sale
of the interest aforesaid hereby conveyed at public auction for cash having given reason-
able notice of such sale and out of the proceeds thereof first pay and satisfy the expenses
of said sale then pay and satisfy the debt and interest due the said Nicholas McNeill
and the balance if any pay the said Vaughan or his personal representatives and should
the said Vaughan pay the debt aforesaid and all costs incurred hereby on the day appointing
whereat shall be due then this Indenture to be void In Witness whereof the parties
have hereunto set their hands and affixed their seals the day & year first aforesaid

This Indenture made this 29th day of October in the year of our Lord 1832
Between James B. Wigwaut of the first part Arthur H. Holliman of the second part and
Charles Wigwaut all of the County of Southampton. Whereas the said Arthur Holliman
on the 24th day of January 1828 in order to secure the payment of the sum of two hundred
and eighty seven dollars and forty one Cents to the said John Wigwaut died by Execu-
tor's sum of Trust of that date convey to the said James B. Wigwaut his heirs &c. the follow-
ing property to wit The plantation whereon the said Arthur Holliman now resides
containing by estimation three hundred and eighty acres more or less upon Trust for the uses
and purposes in the said Indenture mentioned; and whereas since the executing
and delivering of the said Rec of Trust the said Arthur Holliman had fully satis-
fied and paid to the said John Wigwaut the several sums of money thereby secured
