Urquhart and John Urquhart have or hold in the said above described Town and to hold the said Part or parts of land to the said Arthur Holleman his heirs and assigns forever to the only heirs and assigns of him the said Arthur Holleman his heirs and assigns forever. And the said James B. Urquhart and John Urquhart for themselves their heirs and assigns the above mentioned Land, unto the said Arthur Holleman his heirs and assigns in full and ample manner as the said deed warrant by the said Arthur Holleman by the Recd of Trust above recited do warrant the said to the said Arthur Holleman against the claim or claims of the said James B.
