Whereas the said Daniel Williams esq; is indebted unto the said Caw Bowens in the sum of two hundred dollars by Bond bearing legal date with these and demands the same day which debt with the legal interest thereon according the said Daniel Williams is willing and desirous to secure. Iesja Lankford witnesseth that for and in consideration of the premises and also for the further consideration of one dollar to him now paid by the said Iesja Lankford at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents hereunto is hereby acknowledged by the said Daniel Williams has given granted bargained and sold and by these presents does give grant, bargain and sell unto the said Iesja Lankford his heirs and assigns forever the following negroes to wit Negro woman Esther and her children
