Brown in the just sum of two hundred dollars by Bond bearing equal date with these and to demand
the same day which debt with the legal interest thereon according to the said Daniel Williams is
willing and desirous to discharge. Now this Indenture Witnesseth that for and in consideration
of the premises and also for the further consideration of one dollar to him in hand paid by the
said Jesse Sankford at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents the said
Daniel Williams hereby acknowledges that the said Daniel Williams has given granted bargained and sold
and by these presents does give grant, bargain and sell unto the said Jesse Sankford
his heirs and assigns forever the following negroes to wit negro woman Esther and her children
