This Indenture made this 29th day of October 1832 between Alexander P. Peete of the County
of Milhampton of the first part Thomas R. Gray of the same part and Gregory Rawlings and Orissa
Brown of the said part of the same part that the said Alexander P. Peete for and in consideration of
the sum of One Dollar to him and his heirs by the said Thomas R. Gray at or before the making
and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged hath granted sold and
delivered unto the said Gray all the right title interest claim or demand which the
said A. P. Peete is entitled to in the estate of Theophilus C. Peete lately deceased to
have and to hold the above granted interest against the claim of him the said A. P. Peete
or all and every person or persons claiming by or through him to his the said Gray his per-
son and behalf his heirs Executors and administrators upon trust nevertheless that the
said A. P. Peete shall indemnify and save harmless the said Gregory Rawlings and
Orissa Brown in the following debts due as follows to a debt due to the said Rawlings
Bonds for the sum of four hundred dollars and debt due by Bonds to said Brown amount
not recollectable with all interest and costs which shall or may accrue on the same
and shall in no wise make default in the payment thereof when so required
by the said Rawlings and Brown their agents and hereby covenants with the following
parties to this indenture being required by the said Rawlings and Brown or their agents
or legal representatives after legal notice of the time and place of sale to expose to
sale at publick auction in the town of Somerton the above granted interest for costs
and after paying the expenses of this conveyance and the debts due to the said Rawlings
and Brown pay over the balance if any remaining to the said Peete his heirs Executors
administration or assigns and the said Gray for himself his heirs & executors to and
with the said parties hereto faithfully to execute the said terms agreeable to the intent
and meaning hereof and to the intention of the grantor to this indenture so much
of the said interest and no more as shall be due after the amount which may be found
due from him to the estate of the said Theophilus C. Peete to whom he was granted
shall be paid out of the portion to which he may be entitled as one of the distributees
of said Theophilus C. Peete dec'd and the said balance is conveyed as above and no
more any thing as previously expressed to the contrary notwithstanding. In witness
