To whom wife This Indenture made this 31st day of October in the year of our Lord one thousand Eight hundred and thirty two Between Holliday Mottor and his wife Sally of Charlottesville and Henry Denov of the other part witnesseth that the said Holliday Mottor and his wife for and in consideration of the sum of fifty four Dollars unto them in hand paid by the said Henry Denov the receipt whereof the said Holliday Mottor and his wife doth hereby acknowledge and themselves fully satisfied and paid of the sum so paid thereto presents against the said Henry Denov they the said Holliday Mottor having bargained and sold above enfeoffed and confirmed by these presents do grant and assign and sell above enfeoffed and confirm unto the said Henry Denov One certain tract or lot of land containing by estimation Eight acre more or less lying and being situate in the County of Southampton State of Virginia bounded by the land of Henry Denov deceased Wilson Wilson and Said Mottor Beginning at a point on the Drayfield road a corner tree thence to a red oak corner tree thence along to red oak a corner tree between Wilson Wilson and Henry Denov thence along a line of marked trees to a white oak corner tree thence along a line adjoining the said Mottor to a sweet gum a new made corner tree a line of marked trees to the southward at a white oak thence down the said road to the sweet gum beginning a line of unmarked trees belonging or in any wise appertaining unto the said Henry Denov and remanded to him his heirs and assigns forever and every part and parcel thereof to have and to hold the said bargained premises with the appurtenances thereto belonging or in any wise appertaining unto the said Henry Denov his heirs and assigns forever and the said Holliday Mottor his wife Sally for themselves their heirs executors and administrators the said bargained premises and every part and parcel thereof with all their appurtenances clear except and savings from all claims or debts in arrears or otherwise owing unto the said Henry Denov
