

John Crumpler made and entered into this eighth day of November in the year one thousand
 One thousand Eight hundred and thirty two Believers John Crumpler of the first part
 & Brew of the second part: And Phinehas Mr Bailey of the third part all of the County
 Court ampler and state of Virginia Whereas it is agreed that the said John Crumpler bound
 in Consideration of the sum of One hundred and Ten Dollars and 38 Cents which he had
 w due from the said John Crumpler to the said Phinehas Mr Bailey by him bearing
 Even date with this Indenture, as also for and in Consideration of one dollar to him and
 paid by the said Benjamin & Brew the receipt whereof the said John Crumpler
 doth hereby acknowledge, hath given granted bargained, sold aliened and released releasing
 Conferred and by these presents doth give grant bargain & sell aliened and released
 Confirme to the said Benjamin & Brew his heirs and assigns forever all the tract or
 parcel of Land adjoynor Givellere or reside lying and being in the County of Southampton
 in the State of Virginia Containing Six ten acres be the same more or less and bounded as follows to wit: On the East and North by the lands of John Hobble on the South by Suck
 Swamp and on the North by the Proctor Road etc all my right title claim or interest in
 the tract or parcel of Land wherein Sally Hobble now livis and holds under her donee as
 widow of Jeph Hobble dec^d lying and being in the County of Southampton in the State of
 Virginia Containing Ninety Six acres of the same more or less and bounded as follows to wit
 on the North and east by the lands belonging to the heirs of John P. Faddler dec^d on the south
 by the Proctor Road and onto west by Gregrys Branch, wch all and I signify the
 appurtenances to the said tract or parcels of land belonging or in any way pertaining
 and all the Estate right title and interest of the said John Crumpler in and to the said
 granted or intended to be hereby granted tract or parcels of land and premises to have
 and to hold the said hereby granted or intended to be hereby granted tract or parcels of land
 and premises with its or their appurtenances unto the said Benjamin & Brew his heirs &
 assigns and assigns forever to the only properne and behoof of the said Benjamin & Brew
 his heirs Ears, adms and assigns forever And the said John Crumpler for himself his
 heirs Ears and adms doth hereby Covenant promise and agree to and with the said Benj
 & Brew his heirs Ears adms and assigns for ever manner and form following that is
 to say that the said John Crumpler his heirs Ears and adms the aforesaid tract or
 parcels of land and premises with their appurtenances unto the said Benjamin &
 Brew his heirs Ears adms and assigns against all persons what ever shall hereafter
 warrant and forever defend by these presents Upon this Special Trust Mannerly
 that the said Benjamin & Brew upon being thence required by the aforesaid Persons
 & Mr Bailey shall proceed to sell all the right and interest of the said John
 Crumpler to the above named or written named tracts or parcels of land hereby
 conveyed or intended to be conveyed, after advertising the time and place in the said County
 of Southampton for ten days for monys at some publick house or store for each and
 all cost attending the said sale as well as the expenses attorneying the said County and
 and then pay off the Bond aforesaid with interest and the Surplus if any pay the
 said John Crumpler And the said John Crumpler for himself his heirs Ears and
 adms the right and title of the said land unto the said Benjamin & Brew his
 heirs and assigns forever doth hereby warrant and defend against the lawful
 claims of him the said John Crumpler his heirs Ears and adms and against all
